HOW TO PLACE ABID!

Mobile and Desktop

1. Go to: biddingOwl.com/BalboaTeacherEvents
2. Sign up as a bidder using the student's name and room number. This is a one time process so that we have contact information for the bids you place and a way to notify you.
 - a) Please use the student's first & last name and room number. Using your child's name is for tracking purposes only. No payment info is collected at this point.
 - b) Use the parent's email address for contact info.
 - c) Enter a bidder display name that is unique (or repeat student name & room number).
 - d) Create a password.
 - e) Enter the rest of your contact info.
 - f) You will be given a choice to receive an email or text notification (or both) when you are outbid.
 - g) Click "agree to terms and conditions".

NOTE: You can only create 1 user name per email. If you have more than one child at Balboa, bid using your name and then let us know which child will be attending which event when you pay for your auctions.

2. Find an event. Enter the Event Name in the search bar field at the top of the page, then press enter. Click on a listing within that event.

NOTE: you will see multiple listing for each event because each "seat" available in the event is auctioned.
4. Enter your bid amount.
 - a) The minimum bid amount shows as the default. You can start with the opening bid amount, or enter a higher amount in one dollar increments.
 - b) If all seats have a bid, you can raise the bid amount on one of the seats in typical auction fashion.
 - c) If you are outbid (someone raises a bid on your seat), you will be notified via email and/or text and will have the opportunity to enter a new bid amount on that seat, or bid on another seat within the event.
5. Bidding closes at 3pm on Sunday April 15th. Winners will be notified at the close of bidding and will receive an invoice to pay for their event.
6. You will have 72 hours to pay for your winning seat. Payment can be made via credit or debit card per the invoice instructions. If payment isn't received within that time period we reserve the right to give the seat to the next highest bidder.
